### Timeline of the contest

**ATTENTION: the contest has been extended**

**The new dates are:**

- **June 26 - August 7 2013** submit your entry online [www.facebook.com/CpfYouth](http://www.facebook.com/CpfYouth).
  - **August 7 2013:** The jury selects the top 10
- **August 7 - 11 2013 :** participants select by popularity their favourite entries in the top 10 on Facebook. [Share, comment or like to help](#) choose the first, second, and third prize winners. [Note: There must be at least one participant from BC and one from the Yukon in the top 10].
- **The Grand** prizes of \$140, \$110, and \$100 will go to the **three** entries with the top popularity. The seven **other top 10** participants will receive secondary cash prize of **\$50** for their participation. The names of the winners will be revealed **August 12, 2013** [through a link to the CPF BC & Yukon site](#).



- If you don't have Facebook, send in your link, name and explanation to this email (ex: [projects@cpf.bc.ca](mailto:projects@cpf.bc.ca)) for posting on the CPF FB youth page. It will be your responsibility to check back August 3rd to see if you made the top 10.

### **How to participate**

- **All** French speaking students from Gr. 8-12 in British Columbia or the Yukon are eligible to participate.
- **There are** three categories: **music**, **film**, and **literature and other**. Literature and other may include, but is not limited to: novels, magazines, newspapers, comics/graphic novels, fiction or non-fiction books, and online blogs.
- Choose your favourite song, film, book, or other and submit your entry online at [www.facebook.com/CpfYouth](http://www.facebook.com/CpfYouth) in a Facebook post. You are encouraged but not obligated to include:
  1. Your name
  2. Your grade
  3. Your school and municipality
  4. Why you chose your entry; preferably in French!

### **Rules**

#### **Description of the contest**

1. Shuffle Summer 2013 Edition is for French language speaking students to engage online in French with other students during the summer. By choosing and sharing your favourite song, film, or book, you are helping to create a compilation of resources that can be shared with other students in BC and the Yukon. This is a Canadian Parents for French BC & Yukon sponsored contest.

2. The participants are able to submit their entry from June **26, 2013** until August 2, 2013 until midnight.

Participants must include the following information to ensure their entry is taken into consideration in the contest:

1. Choose your favourite French song, film, book, or other.



2. Attach a video, photo, or simply the name of the song, film, or book in a Facebook post: [www.facebook.com/CpfYouth](http://www.facebook.com/CpfYouth)
3. You are encouraged to explain, preferably in French, why you chose the song, film, book, or other.
4. You are encouraged but not obligated to include: your name, your grade, your school, and your municipality.
5. Please include whether you are a BC or Yukon resident
6. Click "post" to submit your entry.
7. Wait until August 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2013 to see if your entry made the top 10.
8. [Like/vote/share or comment](#) for your favourite entry in the top 10 from August 3 to August 7 2013.

### **Types of entries accepted**

For the following categories, participants must respect these specifications:

1. Music: the song must be in French or include some French content and the lyrics must be age appropriate for Gr. 8-12\*.
2. Film: the film must be in French and appropriate for Gr. 8-12\*.
3. Literature and other: The entry may include but is not limited to novels, magazines, newspapers, comics/graphic novels, fiction or non-fiction books, and online blogs. The content must be age appropriate for Gr. 8-12\*.

\*It is the responsibility of the participant to ensure that their entry is age appropriate for Gr. 8-12. Canadian Parents for French BC & Yukon has the right to remove entries that do not satisfy the specifications of the contest.

### **Description of the prizes**

Each of the three grand prize winners will receive the three grand cash prizes of \$140, \$110, and \$100. The other seven participants who qualify for the top 10 but do not receive top popularity will receive a secondary cash prize of \$50.

The winners will be posted on the CPF BC & Yukon webpage. The link will be posted to Facebook when the winners are announced. It is the participant's responsibility to contact us to arrange prize delivery or pick up.



## The Winners

The participant is the person who's name appears on the Facebook post.

1. The contest Shuffle Summer 2013 Edition is open to residents of British Columbia and the Yukon.
2. The participants must be enrolled in a French course whether it is French Immersion, Core French, Intensive French, or a Francophone course. In the goal of respecting Canadian legislation, the participants must be 13 years of age or older.
3. Each participant may submit multiple entries for the contest online at [www.facebook.com/CpfYouth](http://www.facebook.com/CpfYouth). (Note: participants can enter the top 10 only once).
4. The entries must not break or violate the law or any right, especially copyright. By submitting an entry on the website of the contest, the participant testifies that they received all the proper rights, permissions, and authorisations that are necessary. Canadian Parents for French BC & Yukon cannot be held responsible if these conditions are not met.
5. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry if they judge it does not meet the criteria for an acceptable entry as described in these rules or if they judge the entry inappropriate.
